1. The following personal property is deemed surplus property and shall be offered for public sale at online auction:


- a. 2001 John Deere 7610 Tractor, VIN: RWSG060051856



ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1121 A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WARREN COUNTY'S CREDIT CARD POLICY

WHEREAS, the Warren County Commissioners previously passed Ordinance No. 2019-1104A establishing a Credit Card Policy for the County; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Auditor, Sheriff's Department, Highway Department and Circuit Court, the Warren County Health Department has requested a credit card to make small incidental purchases, such that the purchase order process typically used is unduly cumbersome and impractical;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Warren County Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-1-3-6, that Section 35.05 Credit Card Policy is amended as follows:

35.05 CREDIT CARD POLICY

(3) Credit Limits. The Auditor shall set credit limits on each credit card issued; provided, that in no event shall such credit limit exceed \$5,000.00 for any individual credit card nor shall the aggregate credit limits for all credit cards issued to or authorized for use exceed \$25,000.00.

In all other respects, Sec. 35.05 Credit Card Policy of the Warren County Code shall remain the same.
