RESOLUTION NO. 2010-7


Whereas, the County has surveyed railroad crossings within the County with respect to the safety of said crossings, and

Whereas, the Indiana Department of Transportation has assured the County of certain funds, conditioned upon the closing of certain railroad crossings, and

Whereas, it appears the closing of the crossing at Warren County Road 600 South, at the DOT-AAR #484364L Norfolk-Southern Railroad right of way is indicated to be in the interest of the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the County,

It is hereby resolved that the railroad crossing at Warren County Road 600 South, be permanently closed to vehicular traffic at the DOT-AAR #484364L Norfolk-Southern Railroad right of way on both sides of the intersections, the County reserving all utility easements and right of way appurtenant thereto;

Be it further resolved, that this closure be contingent upon the execution of a contract to obtain certain funding from the Indiana Department of Transportation which can be used for the costs of performing the closure and other transportation purposes within the County's jurisdiction.
