

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-0803D

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REGULATION OF SITING
DATA CENTERS IN WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA
TO REQUIRE FUNDING OF ELECTRIC GRID UPDATES**

WHEREAS, Warren County, Indiana previously adopted Ordinance No. 2026-0302 regulating the siting of data centers in Warren County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the elected officials and members of the planning and zoning boards of the County have further researched the siting of data centers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-1-3, et. seq. a government unit has all powers necessary and desirable in the conduct of its affairs, though not granted by statute, for the effective operation of government as to its local affairs; and

WHEREAS, due to concerns about the increased costs of electricity, the County believes that the Applicant/Owner should be responsible for the cost of any electric grid upgrades to minimize the cost to ordinary customers of the utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Warren County Commissioners, that Section V, Design and Installation, Subsection D, Utilities Section 1, Electric of Ordinance No. 2026-0728, is amended as follows:

V. DESIGN AND INSTALLATION

D. Utilities

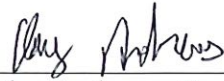
1. Electric

a. If existing capacity and/or supply lines are not adequate at the time of the special exception application, the Applicant/Owner shall provide written verification of the necessary infrastructure upgrades that will be required to serve the proposed use, including any property acquisitions. The Applicant/Owner shall be responsible for all upgrades to the existing capacity and supply lines for the Project

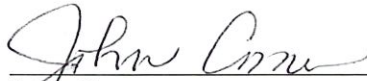
All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2026-0302 shall remain in full force and effect.
