1. New Business:

- b. Hoosier Associates, County Insurance – Blake Shoen explained policies. Deductions did not change. Explained thoroughly all policies.
- c. 2026 Sheriff Contract and Meal Agreement – Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve the 2026 Sheriff Contract and Meal Agreement seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- d. Rezoning Request in Judyville, Collins – Discussed the timeline of the request. Collins explained request is due to adding storage containers. The BZA will meet concerning addition of storage container. Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve Ordinance #2026-0105A approval of rezoning Collin's property in Judyville seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- e. 2026 LEDO Agreement – Tabled until next meeting. Heather Deno, new Executive Director of Warren County Economic Development Organization or LEDO was introduced by Eberly. Eberly stated he will remain with LEDO to continue work on the READI agreements.
- f. Weiland Vacated Ally – Discussed the request for vacation of alley. Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve Ordinance #2026-0105B seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- g. 2026 Appointment of County Bank, Attorney, and Newspaper – Discussed having items on the website rather than the newspaper. John Comer made a motion appointing First Financial Bank as County Bank, Barce and Redlin as County Attorney, Kankakee Valley/Review Republican as County Newspaper seconded by Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.

- d. Commissioner Room Remodel – Update at next meeting.


3. Elected Official/Department Head comments:


