

**WARREN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
MONDAY JUNE 1, 2026**

The meeting was called to order by Clay Andrews, Commissioner President.

Clay Andrews, Commissioner President lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

**1. New Business:**

- a. Add JOINK Service Agreements. Clay Andrews made a motion to approve the amended agenda with a second from John Comer, all voted in favor.
- b. John Comer made a motion to approve May 18, 2026 Commissioner Meeting Minutes seconded by Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.
- c. John Comer made a motion to approve the May 18, 2026 – June 1, 2026 Accounts Payable Claim Dockets with a second from Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.
- d. John Comer made a motion to approve the May 22, 2026 payroll with a second from Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.
- e. Highway – Herndon stated working on culverts and patching. Starting on Independence this week and next week preparing for Reith Riley to start paving. Dump truck has been ordered, should be at the upfitter by October and should be delivered in November.
- f. Purdue Health Department Intern – Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve the agreement between Purdue and Warren County Health Department for Summer Intern seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- g. JOINK Agreements – Agreements are for Fire Departments in State Line/West Lebanon and Williamsport, County buildings. Greg Robison stated State Line Fire Department is wanting the free fiber internet. John Comer made a motion to approve Service Agreements with JOINK seconded by Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor. JOINK and ATT issue discussed as ATT contract has expired while waiting for installation which has created a very larger bill from ATT.

**3. Elected Official/Department Head comments:**

- a. Jim Morson, EMA Director – Still waiting for a response on Multi-Hazard Mitigation plan. County Fair work, EMPG salary grant has been approved. Issue between the new Pool and Fair Barn location of fence with fair traffic and animal unloading was discussed.
- b. Anthony Pruitt, Sheriff – Currently have 5 vehicles to sell (2019, 2020, 2021 and two 2022 Tahoe's). Enterprise has stated approximately \$70,000 for all 5 and is requesting permission to start the process of selling with Enterprise. Clay Andrews made a motion to Declare 5 Sheriff Tahoe's Surplus seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- c. Heather Deno, LEDO Director – Deno explained the trip to DC and meetings with Senator's concerning E15 and rural development. Discussed Federal Grants with State. Many meetings setup in the coming weeks with KIRPC and town clerks for grants, working on duke grant marketing campaign for Warren County businesses, grant from Wabash Valley power for feasibility study.

**4. Public Comment:**

- a. Michelle Stucky, Community Foundation – Stucky explained Moores Hill Road site has been delayed a few weeks due to weather. Kayak kiosk, Barce reviewed the contract/license location agreement and install will be in about 10 weeks beyond the approval. Mural project for Moores Hill Road will be painted mid-July. Stucky requested Commissioners to pick the mural. Discussed the murals, tabled until next meeting.
